### **Examples of duties and activities:**

- Working with a small group of children on a photography scavenger huntmaking sure they know how to use the cameras and guiding them on their assignment.
- Assist with planting trees.
- Assist with an active game, making sure they are following the game "rules."
- Putting snowshoes on a child.
- Working with a small group on a "Bio-blitz" activity to guide and keep
   them on task. (measuring tree circumference, documenting weather observations etc)
- Keeping the class together on a nature hike.
- Assist leader in set –up, distribute and collect activity materials, (clipboards, cameras, pencils, GPS units, etc.), take down at end of day and prepare materials for next group.
